Mickaboo Cockatiel Rescue is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization that rescues companion birds who are either sick, injured, stray or abandoned. We take in over 300 birds annually, all of whom we place in loving, permanent adoptive homes. Many of the birds surrendered to Mickaboo are ill, and our first priority is to procure medical care by certified and pre-certified avian veterinarians. Once the birds are well, they are available for adoption. All adoptive “parents” attend our free bird care seminar prior to adopting from Mickaboo. Our seminar provides the most recent care guidelines for nutrition and well-being in order to ensure the best care possible for the birds in their new homes. As you can imagine, the specialized medical care we seek is very costly. We exist solely on private donations from caring individuals. If you choose to donate to Mickaboo, be assured that all money goes directly to medical costs and supplies for the birds. Everyone who works for Mickaboo does so on a volunteer basis.
