Our Mission Statement:

To provide protection for those who cannot help themselves. To ensure the highest possible quality of life for our companion birds. To educate the bird owning public on the most current diet, health and general care information.



Who We Are

We are a small bird rescue organization located in the San Francisco Bay Area. We are dedicated to the rescue of small parrot-type birds that have been either neglected, abused, sick, or injured. We rehabilitate them when necessary, and place them in safe, caring foster homes until a permanent home can be found. Our



goals are:

We rescue and rehabilitate birds before finding them loving homes.

- To ensure that birds in our care will have a safe, loving environment for life.
- To educate bird owners on the most current care information, so that their bird's medical, emotional, and dietary needs will be met.

HOW FOSTER PARENTS HELP

Our foster parents are caring, conscientious volunteers who care for displaced rescue birds until a permanent home can be found. These individuals are trained through MCR in bird care. They supply food, treats and love while Mickaboo Cockatiel Rescue supplies cages, toys and medical care. Foster parents are expected to drive the foster bird(s) to the vet if necessary (at their convenience); they may also pick up the bird(s) or drop them off at a permanent home. Foster parents may become permanent parents should they wish to do so. Foster parents are the life blood of our organization.

PERMANENT ADOPTION: OUR GOAL

When a bird comes to Mickaboo, we search through our adoption applications for a good match. All permanent adoption parents must have an application on file and must attend a bird education class on bird care. An adoption fee, which varies by species, is paid by the new owners. Birds adopted from MCR may not be sold, given away or used as "breeder stock." If a new owner cannot keep an adopted bird, the bird must be returned to MCR.



We search for loving homes that will provide the best environment for our birds.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

You can become a foster parent. Foster parents are invaluable to us. They are often times the biggest step in changing an orphan birds life. As a foster parent you might be expected to do some driving if necessary, i.e., take the bird to the vet, etc.



There are many ways you can help our birds.

You can become a permanent adoptive parent. It is our ambition to find permanent homes for birds who desperately need a sense of security.

You can become a driver. We often need someone who can pick up and drop of a bird as well as transport it to our vet, etc. If you would like to help, live in the San Francisco Bay Area, and have some extra time on your hands, this might be for you.
